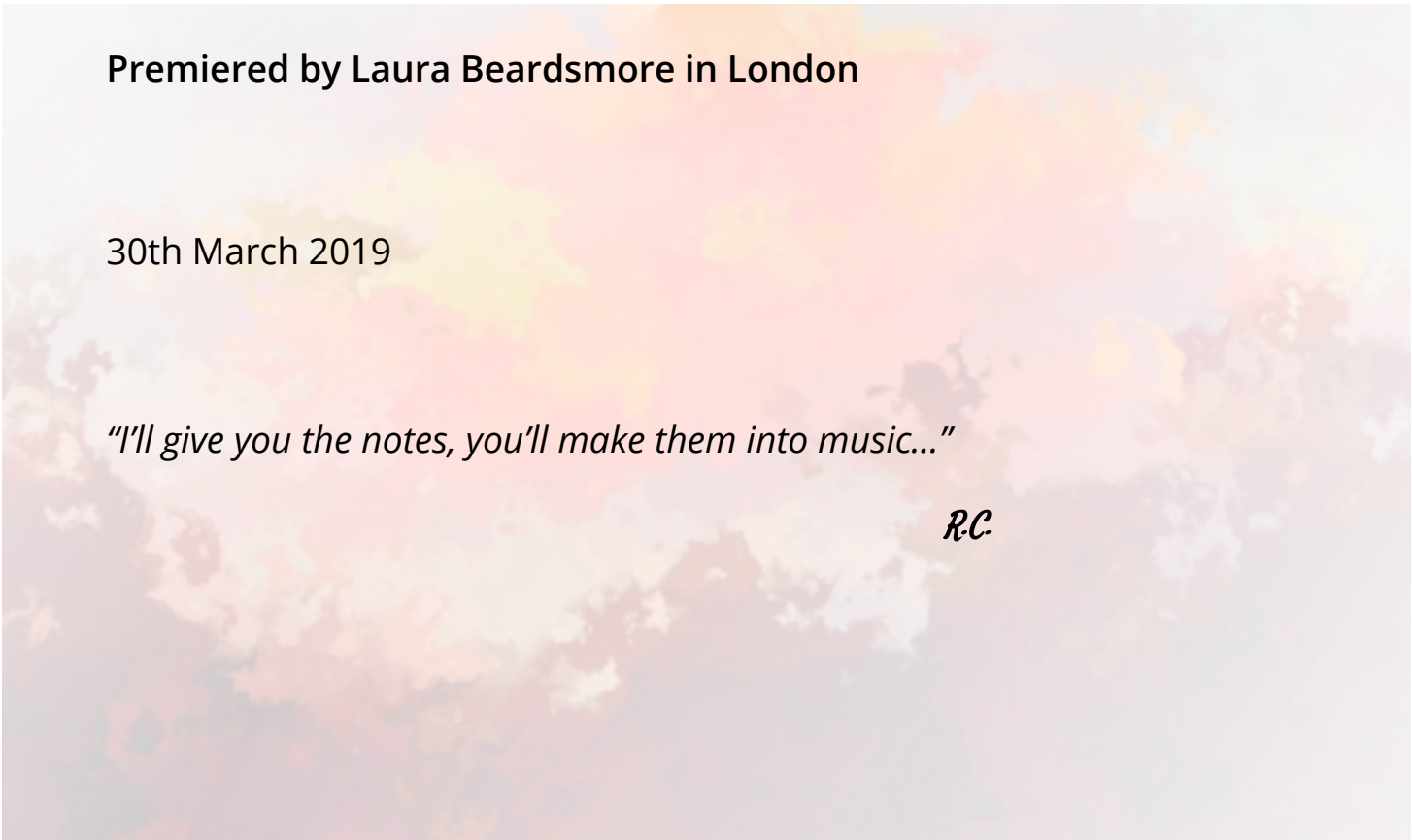

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Fantasy Impromptu-ish, for solo Flute with B foot

Duration: between 60 seconds and 2min30sec

Instructions

- You will find two scores, one is free with improvisational fragments and the other is Moderato where it recommends how these improvisation fragments could be played.
- You are invited to add your own embellishments to both scores specifically with choosing and manipulating the sound colour (timbre).
- In the free score only the boxed music has a specific pulse and is between 98 - 104 BPM. The duration of the notes indicates the relationship between them rather than a strict rhythm (quarter note is longer than quaver but not necessarily two times longer). The chords indicate which group of notes to choose from to create the guided improvised melody.
- If you choose the Moderato score you can still manipulate the time by speeding up arpeggiated fragments and so on.
- For your performance you may choose to play the piece once or two (or more) variations of the piece where you change the sound colour for each variation.

Program note
